Balanced palate and elegant finish, which refers to white flowers.

Medium-bodied and smooth tannins. Complex and persistent aroma of ripe red fruits.
Notes of black tea, black pepper and vanilla.

Contos Chardonnay (Brazil)

R\$ 80

Elegant aroma reminiscent of ripe pineapple, apricot and pear.
Manual harvesting of grapes.

Miolo Single Vineyard Riesling (Brazil)

R\$ 129

White pulp fruit aroma. Floral hints. Vivid acid and fresh structure.

Alamos Chardonnay (Argentina)

R\$ 149

Rich and full-bodied. Citrus fruit aroma.
Floral notes with spices, vanilla, toasted coconut and nuts.

Portillo Salentein Sauvignon Blanc (Argentina)

R\$ 150

Remarkable taste and freshness. Aroma of grapefruit, peach and passion fruit hints.

Trapiche Astica Chardonnay (Argentina)

R\$ 122

Aroma of white and citrus fruits. Fresh taste | mild acidity.

Susana Balbo Crios Torrontés (Argentina)

Aroma of jasmine. Notes of apricot, honey and vanilla. Vivid flavors

Indomita Gran Reserva Chardonnay (Chile)

R\$ 220

Aroma of tropical fruits, such as mango and pineapple and notes of vanilla.
Unctuous and balanced texture.

Casillero del Diablo Reserva Chardonnay (Chile)

R\$ 95

Elegant and medium-bodied, with good balance and acidity.
Complex flavor. A long and sweet finish.

Settesoli Pinot Grigio (Italy)

R\$ 167

Aromatic notes of green apple and citrus fruit. Mild but vivid acidity.

La Vielle Ferme (France)

R\$ 180

White fruit aroma, such as melon and pear. Slightly fruity flavor with herbaceous nuances.
Great acidity.

Reguengos DOC Alentejo (Portugal)

R\$ 98

Fresh, dry and balanced. Fruity aroma.
Syria (70%) and Antão Vaz (30%) grapes harvested manually.

Casal Garcia Vinho Verde (Portugal)

R\$ 113

Lush aroma of citrus fruits with floral notes. Light, fruity and slightly sparkling.

Rosé

Fleur de Passion Cotes de Provence (France)

R\$ 230

Dry, light and with good acidity. Charming finish full of mineral notes. Grenache, cinsault and syrah grapes. Provence region.

* Pairs well with fish and seafood.

Rosé Piscine Stripes (France)

R\$ 210

Extremely refreshing. Fruity aroma with notes of lemon, strawberry, lychee and flowers.

* With ice added to the glass

Casal Garcia Rosé (Portugal)

R\$ 113

Semi dry, slightly sparkling and very refreshing. Light and fruity body. Vinhão, azal and borragal grapes.

Alamos Rosé (Argentina)

R\$ 150

Aromas of ripe red fruits. Fresh style with aroma fruity.

Red Wine

Seival by Miolo Tempranillo (Brazil)

R\$ 80

Very fruity aroma with complex oak notes. Good structure with elegant and persistent tannins. Region of the Southern Campaign, on the border with Uruguay.

Yali Reserva Pinot Noir (Chile)

R\$ 110

Expressive aroma of red fruits with floral nuances. Delicate spice notes.

Catena Malbec (Argentina)

R\$ 245

Complex, intense and concentrated like the great Argentinian red wines. Elegant and subtle. Black cherry and sweet fruit flavor.

San Telmo Cabernet Sauvignon (Argentina)

R\$ 109

Aroma of gooseberry and black pepper. Aged in oak barrel. Soft tannins with long and elegant finish.

Cono Sur Bicicleta Pinot noir (Chile)

R\$133

Vibrant and versatility. Light body, good acidity and very soft tannins.

Carmen Insigne Merlot (Chile)

R\$ 124

Good body and ripe tannins. Aroma of red and dark fruits. Notes of spices and red pepper. Full-bodied, intensely fruity and complex. Smooth flavor and soft tannins.

Sanama Reserva Carménère (Chile)

R\$ 135

Good body and ripe tannins. Aroma of red and dark fruits. Notes of spices and red pepper.

Chilano Syrah (Chile)

R\$ 87

Fruity aroma with toast notes. Silky tannins and persistent finish.

Ventisquero Clásico Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)

R\$ 134

Great aromatic intensity of dark fruits with notes of pepper and vegetable nuances. Medium-bodied. Present tannins and pleasant finish.

Franc Beauséjour Bordeaux (France)

R\$ 217

Light and easy to drink. Fresh acidity and round tannins. Maximum expression of the terroir. Merlot, cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc grapes.

La Vieille Ferme (France)

R\$ 173

Tasty and refreshing. Red fruit aroma. Soft tannins. Carignan, cinsault, grenache and syrah grapes.

Quinta do Cachão Douro (Portugal)

R\$133

Chocolate and toast notes. Ripe and soft tannins, with persistent finish. Aged in French and American oak barrels. Touriga franca, touriga nacional, tinta barroca, tinta Roriz and tinta cão grapes.

Monsaraz DOC Alentejo (Portugal)

R\$ 105

Medium-bodied. Aroma of ripe red fruits with notes of vanilla. Aged in French oak barrels. Trincadeira, aragonez and alicante bouschet grapes.

Quinta de Bons-Ventos (Portugal)

R\$ 123

Very fruity palate, with notes of wood. Full-bodied, with balanced acidity and firm tannins. Castelão, touriga nacional, camarate and tinta miúda grapes. Regional wine from Lisbon.
